

The rounding rule will apply in Estonia from 1 January 2025 for payments in cash

If the buyer pays in cash then the seller rounds the final price of the basket of shopping at the till upwards or downwards to the nearest five cents. This means the final price of the basket of shopping can be up to two cents cheaper or more expensive.

Examples: €3.72 → **€3.70** €3.99 → **€4.00**

Example: a shopping basket of milk, bread and an apple

milk	€1.34
bread	€1.55
apple	€0.48
Total:	€3.37

The final price of the basket of shopping is rounded downwards by 2 cents
